“Michigan Native Wildflowers”

Our speaker will be Sara Thomas. Sara is a naturalist who has served the LLC in numerous ways over many years including as a founding member, past board president, and current land acquisition chair.

Her interesting and wide-ranging program will:

- i) identify some of the native wildflowers growing on the Conservancy's nature preserves, and explain how they can be good choices for your own yard and landscape;
- ii) discuss why native plants are preferred over non-natives in encouraging healthy ecosystems; and
- iii) explain the value of prescribed burns in promoting native flowers and plants.
