

# *Land Protection Efforts in Howell and the Greater Livingston County Area*

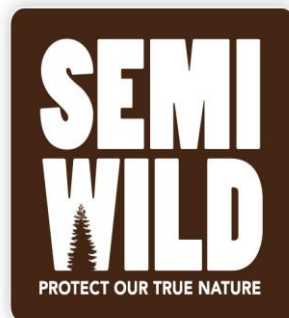
